RE: Payment Policies for COVID Isolation and Quarantine Periods

Dear Families,

Per our payment policies shared during enrollment (and listed in our family handbook) with additional considerations due to the pandemic:

Note: tuition programs include non-GRSP enrollments, including additional before/after/Friday care.



- If a child is out ill (with or without COVID) or absent for another reason, tuition payments must still be made.
 - We equate tuition to car payments. If you are making monthly car payments and you don't drive it for two weeks, you still have to make a full car payment.
 - We reserve a classroom spot for your child and whether they are here or not, that spot is there for them. Our expenses for your child continue to incur, regardless of their absence.
- If we have told you that your child was exposed in the classroom and cannot come in due to a mandatory, school imposed quarantine period, we will waive tuition for the quarantine period.
 - If your child contracts COVID during the school imposed quarantine period, tuition must be made for any additional days needed while they are ill.
- If the child is in quarantine – but it is not school imposed – then tuition will still be charged.
